Then you begin to make it better.

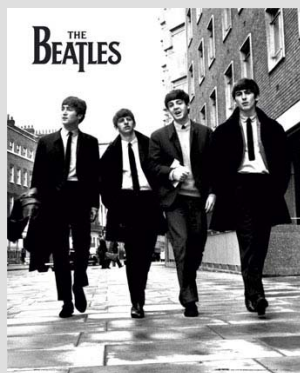
And anytime you feel the pain, hey Jude, refrain,

This laptop makes me crazy !!!!

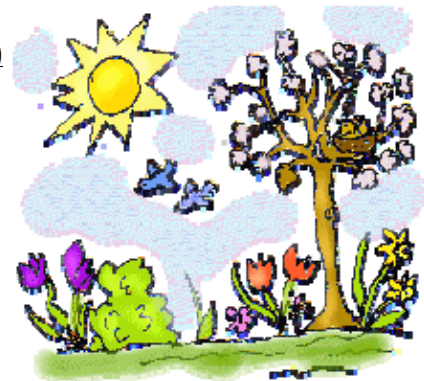


Weather Forecast
