Cider Days in Springfield, Missouri

It's time once again for the 11th Annual Cider Days!

Cider Days is a popular annual fall event featuring crafters, live performances, and handmade foods. The 11th Annual Cider Days will be held on Historic Walnut Street from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., September 20 & 21, 2008 in Downtown Springfield.

Historic Walnut Street is located two blocks north of Missouri State University just off National Avenue. This street is the location of Cider days and the local Arts Fest in early May. There are beautiful older historic houses lining both sides of the street.

The two-day fall festival will feature artists and crafters, three performance stages, a Scarecrow Village, Commercial Street Loft Walk, vintage cars display, a free hands-on children's area with inflatables, and much more! Last year's event attracted more than 15,000 individuals to the annual celebration.



Artists and crafters from across the region exhibit at Cider Days, selling a variety of handmade products. They can often be found demonstrating the various arts and crafts at their individual booths. Activities will include mask making, watercolor painting, chalk drawings, beaded jewelry, and card making.

Moreover, a lot of individual performers showcase their artistic skills on three Cider Days performance stages including the Bandstand Stage, Showwagon Stage, and "Music at the Inn" Stage. The festival features local and regional talent including musicians, dancers, singers and more.

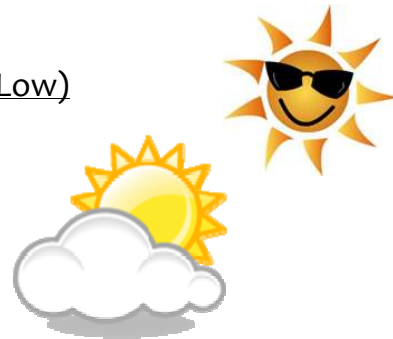
