The first Friday of each month brings hundreds of people to downtown Springfield for the First Friday Art Walk, a Springfield cultural happening in the Downtown Arts District. Art lovers “Walk the Walk,” enjoying original art, music, demonstrations, and performances in 25 gallery venues.

First Friday Art Walk is a grassroots event established by downtown’s art galleries with the support of participating venues, sponsoring businesses and the arts community. The Art Walk is a program of the Springfield Regional Arts Council, and it is dedicated to promoting the Downtown Arts District.

For October, live music and interpretive dance are also prepared as usual. Catch the sounds of Alexander Kofi at Global Fayre, Guitarist Ray Smith at Hawthorn Galleries, and the acoustic artistry of Steve Craven and Ryan Hensen at Springfield Hot Glass Studio. In addition, Randy Bacon Photography Studio & Gallery will present Interpretive Dance by Lindsey Sanders.

Just take a stroll through downtown Springfield and enjoy fine art, delightful music and good food. Throughout downtown you can explore downtown galleries, artist's studios and other venues. You will also find local treasures in the latest sculpture, pottery, blown glass, photography, paintings, and much more.
